

Overexpression of a sorghum *SnRK1βγ2* gene increases the biomass in *Setaria viridis*, but not in rice

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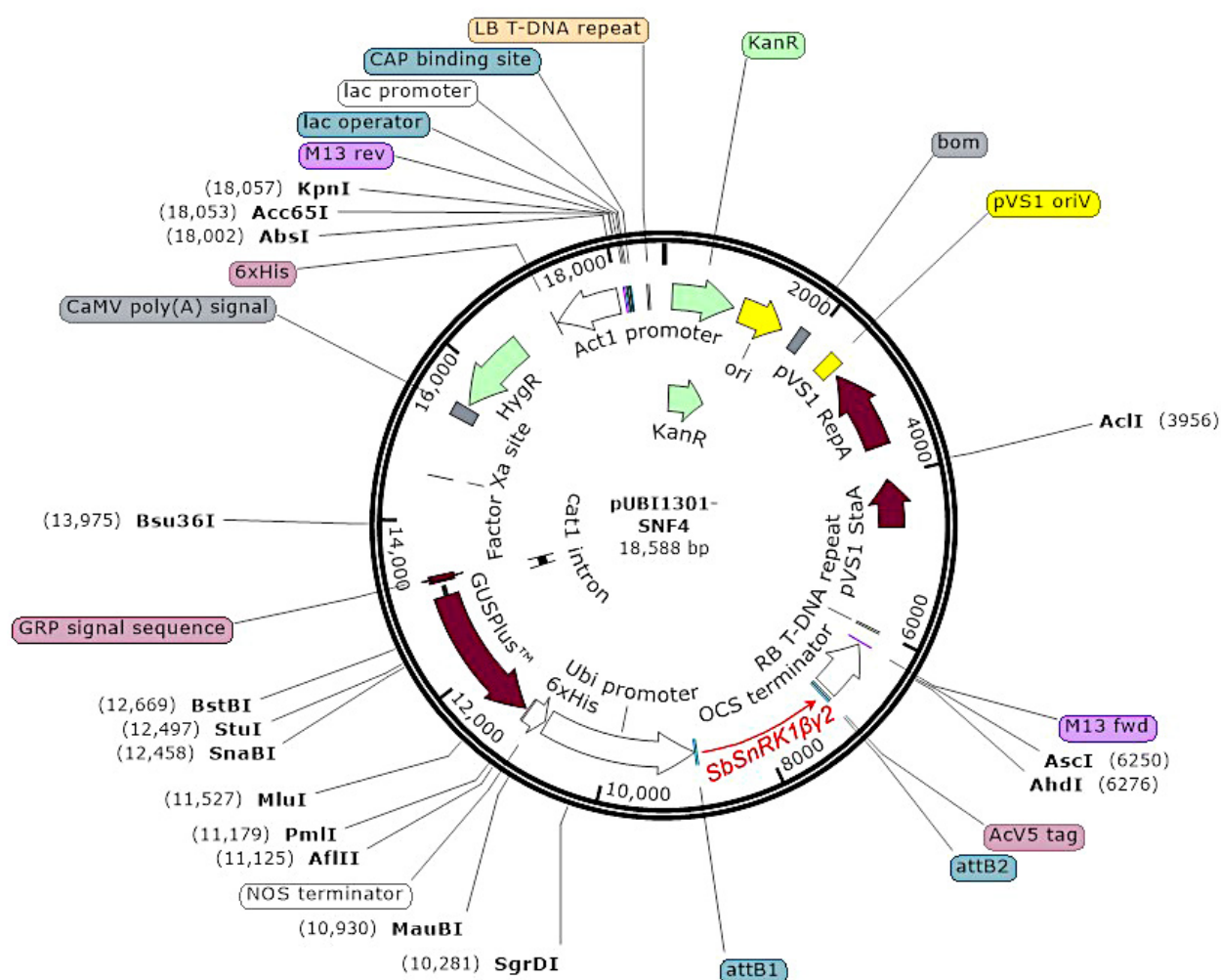


Figure S1. Gene construct used in this study
